INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

The college has seen a considerable growth in infrastructure commensurate with the academic developments that have taken place over the past few years. At present 9 class rooms including virtual class room, separate labs for all science subjects, English language and computer labs in addition to Ladies waiting room, staff and office rooms along with the principal chamber. Sufficient furniture for students, teaching and non teaching staff, library, JKC and NSS is available. A class room is upgraded as Virtual class room to enable the use of innovative, ICT teaching techniques.

LAN facility is available to take practical examinations for MPCs, B.COM (COMP) and general English courses .The College provides Wi-Fi facility to enrich ICT teaching methods.

MANA TV lessons by eminent lecturers all across the state are being displayed in all the subjects through telecast to the students. The VIRTUAL class room present on the campus is the major source of e- learning. Apart from regular computer courses , the computer lab equipped with 22 computers is being kept under use to teach general foundation courses such as ICT (Information & Communication Technology) I, II, CSS (Communication Skills & soft skills and other basic computer courses .

The college library has all departmental text books, rare books, special reports as knowledge resources, and the books are kept open for circulation. Basic requirements like clean toilets with sufficient water supply separately for teachers and students and drinking water facility are available.

The college has a spacious play ground of about 3 acres with various play courts well marked off separately for boys & girls. For maintenance of LAB, ELOCTRONIC, SPORTS, NSS and all other college instruments, the college has constituted **different committees.** Yearly fund is being allotted to maintain and upgrade various devices. The introduction of a number of supportive facilities ensures smooth implementation of the numerous co-curricular activities. Maintenance of all these is given primary importance.
